

#### □ **Procedure**

Steps from Application to Enrollment.

#### **% KBC stands for Kawahara E-Business College**

- STEP1.Applicant send KBC to Application documents by PDF.Payment application fee ¥20,000.Bring it directly to KBC or Transfer (Bank account is above⑥)
- STEP2. Screening and Skype interviews.
- STEP3. Applicant mail to KBC Completion of original documents.
- STEP4. KBC considers application and approves / declines and send "Acceptance letter ".
- STEP5. On behalf of applicants, KBC applies for 『Certificate of eligibility form』 to the Immigration Bureau.
- STEP6. Immigration Bureau notifies us of the visa approval / disapproval, KBC informs the applicants of the result.
- STEP7. KBC sends to the applicant "Certificate of eligibility" "Admission permit" "Bill for the school fees" etc

STEP8. Applicant applies and receives student visa from Japanese embassy or consulate in their home country with [the Certificate of Eligibility]. Preparation to go to Japan.

- STEP9. Payment of fees : First year 1<sup>st</sup> payment
   Entrance fee, Accident Insurance, Housing expenses, Tuition and Material fee etc.
   Bank transfer : Late September, Late March
- STEP10. Please notify KBC by e-mail message in advance of the day you expect to arrive in Japan.
- STEP11. Arrival in Japan, Entrance ceremony
- STEP12. Orientation, intensive course (manners training, Traffic safety course etc), Placement test.
- STEP13. Start of Japanese classes.
